

2026 Fact Sheet

Purpose: To provide a crossover program that builds on the dance training received in the Pre-Pro workshop (and/or your studio's dance programs) and prepares dancers for the potential move into the Go Pro workshop in the future. Also, to continue to advance students in the areas of technical dance skills and performance ability. And finally, to build confidence and introduce the dance profession as a possible career option for dance students who are seriously ready to train hard for it.

Date: Sunday, July 26 to Wednesday, July 29, 2026

Location: Branson, Missouri (Thousand Hills Resort Hotel on Wildwood)

Full Program Fee: \$1,270.00 total prior to any discounts being applied (\$1,070.00 AFTER SCHOLARSHIP).

Discount: \$200.00 Scholarship awarded to selected dancers (limit one scholarship discount per dancer).

Online Application:

Online Application: To begin the application process, log on to talentonparade.com and click on the Special Events Link at the Top of the home page, then go down to the Progressions link and proceed with registration!

Complete the required registration form and submit. Dancer is not accepted into the program until you have paid the deposit as required on the PayPal invoice sent by TOP. All deadlines must be met on time to stay registered in the program. Please be aware that program quickly fills every year and builds a waiting list ... do not wait if you are planning to attend. Registrations will be processed as received. Dancers will be notified by email if being placed on the waitlist.

Application Deposit: \$250 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit required to enroll. **Deposit must be paid within seven business** days after receiving the dancers PayPal invoice for the program.

Payment Deadlines: Souvenir t-shirt fee(s) and private room upgrade fees are due upon initial program registration and will be billed as part of your minimum amount due on your PayPal invoice.

2026 Invoice balance deadlines are as follows:

Balance must be under \$410.00 by May 8, 2026

Balance must be under \$300.00 by May 29, 2026

Balance must be under \$150.00 by June 12, 2026

Balance must be Paid-in-Full by June 26, 2026

Method for all payments is online via the PayPal invoice you will receive from TOP; you may also share your PayPal link for others to "donate" to your dancer's tuition payments. PayPal invoice reminders will be sent out to all accounts with a balance showing due.

Accommodation: Thousand Hills Resort Hotel Branson, all rooms have two double beds. There is no tuition discount if you choose to stay outside of our program rooms during the event.

Rooming options are as follows:

- 1) TOP assigned roommate Two dancer/guardian pairs sharing a room that do not know each other
- 2) Shared Room Request- You name the dancer/guardian pair you want to share the room with during program
- 3) Private room \$475.00 upgrade fee Dancer/Guardian pair has room to themselves (up to 4 people total)

Age Limit: Program is by invitation only and open to intermediate/advanced dancers ages 12 & Older

Transportation: Transportation of each dancer is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian attending the event. Program occasionally includes separating the students into groups at separate locations. If you are riding with someone else, please let Don know during his parents' meeting for that class.

Meals: All meals will be the responsibility of the accompanying parent/guardian. No meals provided by TOP.

Activities Schedule: Pertinent information will be emailed to fully paid participants approximately 5 days prior to the workshop starting.

Show Tickets: Program includes bands for one dancer and one parent/guardian for Sunday performance of The Kidz Roc Show at The Clay Cooper Theatre. You will sit as a group in our designated section of the theatre. Any others attending with you will need to purchase their own ticket to attend.

Participant Supervision: Full, appropriate supervision will be provided for the participants during the workshops. Each dancer & parent/guardian will be expected to always assume full responsibility for his or her actions. Rules of conduct will be established, and participants will be expected to comply. Breaking of the rules may result in immediate expulsion from the workshop without refund.
